Winemaker Alison Doran’s tasting notes:

The 2017 Belle Radici offers aromas of red cherry, plum, violets and nice French oak spice. The palate is young, charming and smooth with lots of cherry, plum, and red berry fruit. A few tannins in the center let you know that this is a Cabernet Sauvignon with a lot of mountain fruit. This wine will continue to organize and mature for years.
