2022 ALBARIÑO

Napa Valley

The Stewart Ranch in Carneros has its toes in the estuary south of Napa and stays cool and breezy. The 2022 season did not allow for much planning ahead: another drought year, then spring frosts, a cool summer, and in mid-August the first of 2 hot spells with intermittent rain. We were pleased to have brought in the Stewart Ranch Albariño on August 23, at 20.7 Brix on a nice foggy morning, though it reached 96 degrees by afternoon! The 2022 Albariño offers beautiful floral, pear and stone fruit aromas. Flavors include tart green apple and nectarine, with tangy lemon and lemon acidity on the long finish.

2021 STEWART RANCH PINOT NOIR

Napa Valley

Composition: 100% Pinot Noir Production: 530 cases / Enjoy Between: 2023-2028 Retail Price: \$58

The Stewart Ranch vineyard in Carneros has a cool breezy climate that brings out the depth and finesse of the Pinot Noir grape. In 2021 we had low winter rains, with budbreak in mid-March and flowering in mid-May. The season unfolded with only moderate heat spikes and cool temperatures in the mornings. We brought in the Pinot Noir in 2 lots 6 days apart: the first lot was 3 tons at 22 Brix, and the second lot was 5 tons at 25.5 Brix. The wines developed as we had predicted, with the earlier pick having delicate characters, and the second having deeper, more powerful elements. The 2021 Stewart Ranch Pinot Noir has welcoming aromas of wild cherry, clove, baking spices and elderberry. The palate is graceful and balanced, with savory spicy plum, tart red currant, and a satiny texture on the finish.

2019 RED DOOR

Napa Valley

Composition: 76% Cabernet Sauvignon, 14% Malbec, 6% Petit Verdot and 4% Merlot / Production: 404 cases Enjoy Between: 2023-2034 / Retail price: \$98

Red Door is a wine blended to take advantage of our best lots that work together in the most rich and flavorful way, regardless of variety or sub-appellation. In 2019, Cabernet Sauvignon from Windy Flats vineyard had the most intense flavors, spice, and structure. Small lots of Malbec and Petit Verdot were also useful together building intensity and complexity. Merlot from Beau Terre Vineyard added boysenberry fruit and depth. From these outstanding lots we created a small quantity of amazing wine. The 2019 Red Door has an expansive nose of black licorice, fruity Halawi date, cassis, and dark chocolate. The palate rolls smoothly along with plushy blueberry and blackberry flavors, deep ripe texture, and a jammy cherry and mocha finish.

2021 WINDY FLATS ZINFANDEL

Napa Valley

Composition: 91% Zinfandel, 8% Petite Sirah and 1% Syrah Production: 194 cases / Enjoy Between: 2023-2028 Retail Price: \$46

The Windy Flats Vineyard is in Wooden Valley carved into the cliffs on the western side of the Vaca mountains. The Zinfandel comes from a section just below the highest point of the vineyard. Growing conditions were challenging in 2021 due to less than normal rainfall, but the canopy held up well through the season until we harvested the grapes on September 22 at 30 Brix. This variety is seen as a uniquely Californian grape with roots in eastern Europe, and with Windy Flats Vineyard, we have a great opportunity to create a small amount of high-quality Zinfandel. The 2021 Windy Flats Zinfandel offers aromas of milk chocolate, raspberry and thyme. The palate is balanced, and still has tannin showing under the raspberry, cranberry fruit, graham cracker and toasted almond flavors.

FRESH HALIBUT

with asparagus and potatoes

The combination of fish and red wine might come as a bit of a surprise to some of you, but the combination of halibut and Stewart Ranch Pinot Noir is fantastic. While we are suggesting halibut for this recipe, a piece of salmon can work as well. However, if it is skin on, be sure to cook it skin side up, to ensure some crispiness. In this recipe we take a minimalist approach to seasonings, allowing the fresh ingredients to sing for themselves. The recipe written is for two, but it can be scaled up or down.

Ingredients

2 halibut filets

1 bunch of asparagus, (NOTE: Parboiling is optional, but it does wonders for the color: to do so, boil for three minutes in salted water, drain and refresh in a bowl of ice water)

12 small, boiling potatoes, cut into ¾ - 1-inch chunks Extra virgin olive oil

Omnivore Salt (this can be found online or at specialty food shops. We recommend it highly, but Kosher salt or sea salt work well here, too) Freshly cracked pepper

Directions

Preheat the oven to 375°. In a large bowl, toss the potato chunks with a coating of extra virgin olive oil, a pinch of Omnivore Salt and freshly cracked pepper. Spread them on a baking sheet and put them in the top third of the preheated oven for 12 minutes.

While the potatoes are roasting, toss the asparagus spears in olive oil, salt and pepper as above.

When the potatoes have been in the oven for 12 minutes, turn them, pushing them to one side of the baking sheet. If they are showing good browning, go ahead and place the asparagus spears on the other side. If they are not browning, let them roast for 4 more minutes before adding the asparagus. Roast together for 6 minutes.

While the potatoes and asparagus are roasting, sprinkle the fish with salt and pepper. Cook for 8 - 12 minutes, or until the fish is done to your liking, and there is good browning on the potatoes and slight browning on the asparagus. Check once the fish has been in the oven for 6 minutes and keep an eye on everything. If the potatoes and asparagus are done, they can be removed and held in a warm part of the stove.

When the halibut is done to your liking, plate and enjoy!
