As always, Atlas Peak Cabernet Sauvignon offers both elegance and power in equal parts, and a well-deserved reputation for intensity and finesse. At an elevation of 1,500 feet, the Baker vineyard is a series of different volcanic soil types carved out of heavy chaparral in Foss Valley with a southwestern exposure, featuring several clones and rootstalks selected for their suitability to the thin, rocky soil. Vines must work harder to find nutrients and water, which ultimately allows them to flourish. Under these conditions, the vines produce smaller clusters with tiny berries, which makes a concentrated and powerful wine.

Atlas Peak Cabernet Sauvignon deserves some time in the bottle, and those who can wait will be rewarded.
