Composition: 89% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Merlot, 2% Petite Sirah 1% Malbec and 1% Petit Verdot

Vineyards: Baker, Bianchini, Beau Terre, Spiteri, Hansen, Davis, Valhalla, Tjain, Obsidian Ridge and Windy Flats

Cooperage: 18 months in 15% new French oak as follows: Treuil Terroir, Tonnellerie O, Remond, Trust Hungarian, Nadalier Noisette, Bossuet, Nadalier Colbert, Nadalier Privilege, Trust 5Star, Orion.

Alcohol: 15.4%, TA 5.6, pH 3.77

Year after year, our Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is a winemaker's dream to create. We only use fruit from Vineyards that Doug Hill controls and manages. Each vineyard, each block, each clone has been harvested, fermented and aged as a separate lot, which gives us almost unlimited blending opportunities. Each vineyard site is meticulously farmed to bring out the best aromas, flavors and textures. This wine is a masterclass in blending possibilities, since even the smallest amount, (as little as 1%) of any given lot can change the finished wine. With so many possibilities available, this is one of my favorite wines to create. Once again, these vineyard sites rewarded us with complex aromas, perfectly ripe fruit, plenty of dark berry and cherry flavors, and a silky texture even at this young age. Please have patience, if you can, and give this wine a little time in the cellar.

Winemaker Alison Doran's tasting notes:

The 2023 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon offers notes of blackberry, cassis, and black cherry. Subtle hints of vanilla and mocha add depth, and the smooth texture on the palate leaves a lasting impression. The wine reveals layers of complexity with velvety tannins and flavors of cassis, plum, and chocolate, and the finish is long and elegant.
